SUBJECT: Resolution approving preferred Circulation Alternative
Comprehensive General Plan Update

RECOMMENDATION:

By motion, adopt the Resolution approving preferred Circulation Alternatives related to the Comprehensive General Plan Update.

BACKGROUND:

On August 2, 2001, the City Council reviewed Land Use and Circulation Alternatives prepared for the General Plan Update. During the meeting, the Council expressed support for the preferred Circulation Alternative to be incorporated into the General Plan Update. The Council directed Staff to prepare a resolution memorializing the selected Circulation Alternative.

The main issue regarding the preferred Circulation Alternative is the alignment of Highway 79. As shown on the attached exhibit, the preference for Highway 79 is an alignment that is parallel to and east of Sanderson Avenue by approximately 1000 feet to the southern boundary of the EMWD sewer treatment facility. The route then trends southwesterly along the existing aqueduct to just north of the intersection of Warren Road and Esplanade Avenue. From that point south to the City limit line, the roadway is on the existing Warren Road alignment.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Comprehensive General Plan Update has been put on hold while the Highway 79 alternatives have been developed. Adoption of the Resolution approving the selected Circulation alternative will allow for the Comprehensive General Plan Update to again move forward.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

None anticipated.

WHEREAS, the City Council after careful review and consideration of identified constraints selected a Preferred Circulation Alternative; and



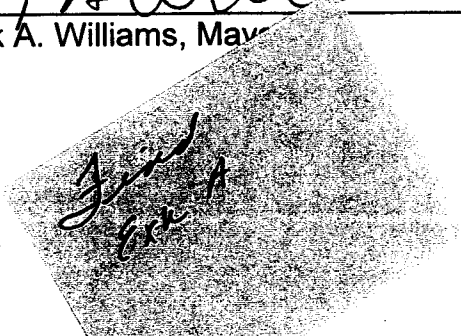

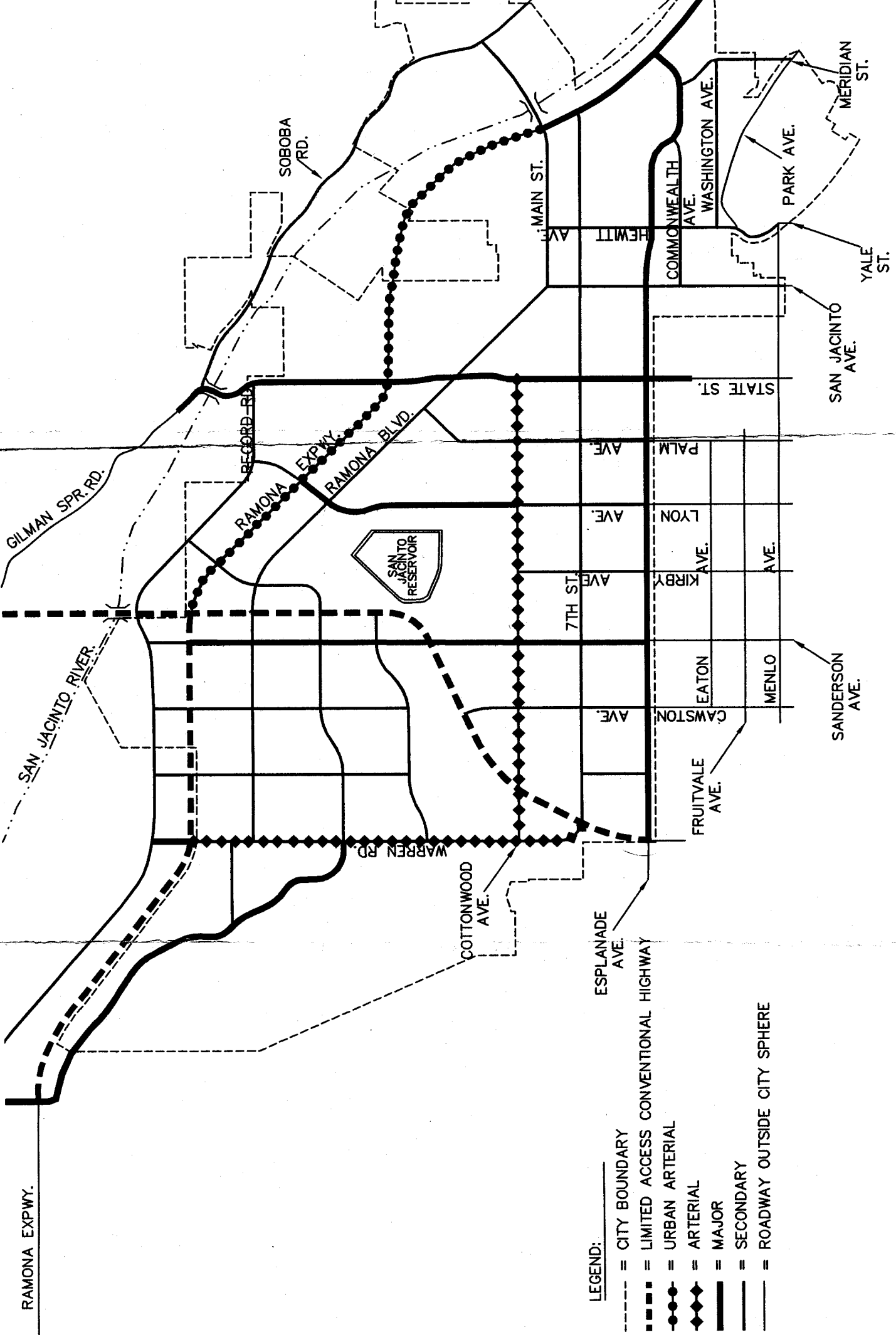
